

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

CITY OF STACYVILLE

Mayor Paul Halbach called the regular February meeting of the Stacyville City Council to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, February 24, 2025, with council members Roger Brumm, Alex Emerson, Roger Hemann, Jake Gerbig, and Allyn Brumm present. The Mayor then welcomed all guests and called for approval of the meeting agenda. Hemann moved to accept the agenda seconded by Gerbig. No Minutes for approval. All voted aye.

The Mayor reviewed the 2025/2026 budget numbers with the council. Hemann and R. Brumm seconded to set a date at our March meeting for the public hearing. All voted aye.

The Mayor discussed the City Clerk's Position regarding hiring a new candidate. The council agreed to hire a new candidate and would work on an updated job description. R. Hemann agreed to follow – up with St. Ansgar about their city clerk fill-in. Looking for a quick turnaround time to gather all the information and inform the public. All voted aye.

No Members of the Stacyville Kids Care board were present. Further discussion was had about the Stacyville Kids Care and Stacyville Community Center Building being built. Greg Steinberg is confirmed to be the architect for this project. R. Hemann confirmed the windows and doors were ordered for updating the current building. Due to the timeframe of both buildings being updated, the Kids Care is being directed to utilize the extra room in the Kids Care area and conduct renovations to meet the needs of the list of kids. The projected timeframe to be done is expected to be late spring/early summer. All voted aye.

Shannon Adams was present to discuss updates about her city events. Currently working on the 3rd season of Tuesdays on Broad and is seeking approval of blocking off Vernon Street as well as Chatham and Lawrence Street around the park. Gerbig moved and Hemann seconded for approval of closing the streets for these three events.

The next regular meeting will be held on March 10, 2025 at 7:30 p.m.
