

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

CITY OF STACYVILLE

Mayor Paul Halbach called the special March meeting of the Stacyville City Council to order at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 26, 2025, with council members Roger Brumm, Alex Emerson, Roger Hemann, and Allyn Brumm present. Absent was Jake Gerbig. The Mayor then welcomed all guests and called for approval of the meeting agenda. A. Brumm moved to accept the agenda seconded by R. Hemann and carried.

The Mayor discussed the hearing date for the 2025/2026 budget to be set for our next meeting scheduled for April. R. Hemann moved and R. Brumm seconded to set the date for April 14, 2025, at 7:30 p.m. at the Stacyville Public Library. Motion Carried.

The Mayor discussed the status of the City Clerk position and reviewed documentation to move forward with posting of the position. Position will be posted online (Indeed, Mitchell County Jobs, Stacyville.com, Facebook) along with flyers around town. Those that are interested have until Friday, April 11 to fill out an application and turn it into Bisbee Income Tax or email stacyvilleiacommunity@gmail.com. The position is part-time at roughly 25 hours a week with 6 major holidays off. Council members reviewed the job description and posting and made edits as a council. R. Hemann moved and A. Emerson seconded on reviewing the applications after the deadline. All voted aye.

Luke Hackenmiller was present and discussed computer options for the City Clerk office. Purchasing a printer, desktop computer, 1 monitor, mouse, keyboard, and any software applications as needed. A. Brumm moved and R. Hemann seconded the motion to order the equipment and software. All voted aye.

The Mayor discussed that in the new city clerk building, Omnitel will need to be contacted regarding internet and a phone line.
