

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS CITY OF STACYVILLE

Mayor Paul Halbach called the regular August meeting of the Stacyville City Council to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, August 12, 2024, with council members Alex Emerson, Roger Brumm, and Roger Hemann present. Allyn Brumm and Jake Gerbig were absent. The Mayor then welcomed all guests and called for approval of the meeting agenda. R. Brumm moved to accept the agenda seconded by Emerson and carried. Hemann moved and Emerson seconded to approve the minutes. All voted aye.

Josh Tarbell and Rustin Lingbeek were not present to discuss the replacement of the Lawrence Street Bridge but did email updated details. Their Option #1 is to move the bridge east to miss the sewer line. Option #2 is to cap the sewer line going north on Lawrence Street. The council spent much time discussing those options. If the sewer line is capped, then the water will need to go east and connect with the manhole at Main and Water. The problem with that is that the existing line going to the lift station would not be big enough to handle the extra water. If the sewer line is not capped the council was concerned about that line breaking since the bridge opening will be larger and thus a longer sewer pipe will be exposed.

Gordy Cimmiyotti is in the process of having the platting done on his 10 lots.

A citizen requested and stop sign to be installed at North Liberty and West College. Hemann moved and Emerson seconded to install the stop sign for east bound traffic. All voted aye.

Emerson moved and R. Brumm seconded to approve the Liquor License for Gerbs Bar and Grill. All voted aye.

Hemann moved and Emerson seconded by RESOLUTION 2024-7 TO APPROVE THE STATE OUTSTANDING DEBT OBLIGATIONS REPORT. All voted aye.

The notice on the web site to provide the City the type of water line pipe coming into the resident's home only yielded eleven responses. The Inventory report is due to the DNR in October. The City will try door hangers or visiting with residents next.

Neighbors of the property owned by Mark & Kim Adams are still concerned about the junk that is on that property. The Sheriff Department is issuing fines.
